The Mexico Center is seeking 12 undergraduate students, especially from underrepresented backgrounds, to participate in the 2018-2019 cycle of the UTSA Mellon Humanities Pathways Fellowship Program. Students accepted into the program receive an introduction to humanities research methods, networking opportunities with UTSA faculty and staff, and professional development and mentoring that leads to graduate study in the humanities.

Benefits

Fellows Will:

- Attend regular workshops to enhance oral and written communication skills, develop research skills, and prepare for graduate school
- Conduct research with a UTSA faculty member
- Participate in a summer workshop that will help with graduate applications and preparation for the GRE General Exam
- Have the opportunity to publish research results and attend conferences with UTSA faculty mentors
- Receive a stipend



Requirements

Applicants Must:

- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher (on a 4.0 scale)
- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Be a junior enrolled in a UTSA bachelor's program in the humanities (broadly defined)
- Demonstrate potential and expressed interest in pursuing research and graduate school in the humanities
